



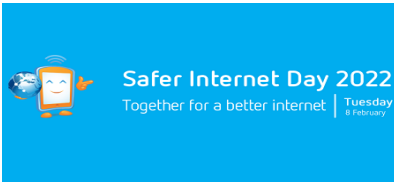
DIARY DATES
